# Brown Opinion Project: April 2024 Poll Results



# Methodology

The Brown Opinion Project (BOP) conducted its April 2024 poll from April 9 - April 11. BOP solicited responses from Brown undergraduate students near Faunce Hall and Sciences Park. BOP representatives asked every person who passed their location if they were interested in taking a quick anonymous poll. Responses were anonymously collected using Google Forms. Over the course of the polling process, BOP collected 554 total responses from Brown undergraduate students.

# **Self-Reported Demographic Information**

The sample of undergraduate students who took the poll is demographically similar to the Brown undergraduate student population on campus. The sample was 29.4% first-years, 23.4% sophomores, 23.1% juniors, and 24% seniors. The sample was 46.2% female, 50% male, 4.7% non-binary or genderqueer, 1.3% questioning or unsure; while 0.5% preferred not to indicate their gender. Additionally, 56.1% of respondents identified as white, 36.6% as Asian, 9.6% as Black, 9.2% as Hispanic, 3.4% as Middle Eastern or North African, 0.9% Native American or Alaska Native, 0.9% Native Haiwaiian or Pacific Islander while 0.7% preferred not to answer. The percentages for race add up to more than 100 percent because some respondents identified as Social Science concentrators, 32.9% of respondents identified as Social Science concentrators, and 0.2% of respondents selected prefer not to answer.
